COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Joan Vibber who then led the group in the pledge of Allegiance. Present were Ken Herrell, Randy McKown, and John Pagnotta. Pat Christensen, Dan Hershey, and Mark Van Sickle were absent.

The committee reviewed Ordinance 660-11, the ordinance that established the police committee. The committee wanted to review the ordinance to make any suggestions to the council for possible changes. It was reviewed and agreed upon that no changes needed to be made.

The committee discussed the options of having the meeting on a different night of the week. It was decided to continue to have the meetings on the 1st Wednesday of each month at 7 p.m.

The committee discussed the chief being a working chief.

The graffiti on the concrete barriers on the east end of town was discussed.

The committee talked about the police patrolling inside the city limits unless being called or assisting another agency. They discussed the use of police cars. McKown stated that the council had agreed that the police vehicles could only be taken out of town when officers are on official police business. The committee wanted to ask the police what area is patrolled, inside or outside city limits and what their responsibility is when assisting another agency. The committee asked if we could get a map that clearly marks the city limits.
