COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES**

Meeting was held at Cottonwood Links Golf course.

Mayor Christensen called the meeting to order. Those present were Trustees Baldwin, Hagerman, Hitchcock, McKown, Stites, and True. Also present were Snider, Klinkerman, and Pagnotta.

Public Comment: None

Changes to the Agenda: None

Approval of previous minutes (June 14, 2010) Trustee McKown made a motion to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. Motion was seconded by Trustee Stites and passed unanimously.

Mayor's Report - Mayor Christensen thanks Trustee Hitchcock for conducting the last council meeting. He commented on the pool and stated the Tori Harris is doing a good job managing the pool.

Committee board reports - None

Administrator Report - Snider reported that Jerry Neely has applied for a USDA grant to install solar in the RV Park.

#### Unfinished Business

School Subdivision - Snider stated he has not heard anything from the school and moving forward with the subdivision is on hold until he hears from the school.

#### New Business

Sierra Club - Mayor Christensen stated he had several trustees with concerns on being members of the Sierra Club. Snider stated the Town is a member of the Cool Cities program, but no membership dues are being paid to the Sierra Club.

Library IGA and establishment of municipal library - Trustee Stites stated the town needed to make a resolution to establish a municipal library. It was noted in the minutes from 1912 that a resolution was passed establishing the library, but the resolution was not found. Stites stated the current library board would like to be an advisory board and not a governing board. Stites made a recommendation that the town sign an IGA stating the responsibilities of the library board and the town. Stites stated she would like to make a few changes to the IGA and feels that because of these changes; the council is not prepared to sign the IGA at this time.

Pool Manager Responsibilities - Trustee Stites stated the pool manager has requested to extend the hours of operation of the pool by opening from 1 to 4:30. The pool was approved to open on Thursdays. Treasurer Klinkerman explained the issue of revising

the budget and explained the cost involved in opening the pool extra hours. Stites made a recommendation to allow the pool manager to make the decisions with the hours of operation. Trustee Hitchcock stated his concerns with opening the pool longer and the risk of going over the budget. Trustee Hitchcock made a motion to give the pool manager the authority to make the decisions with the hours of operation. Trustee True added that he would like Tori to work closely with Klinkerman and Snider. Motion was seconded by Trustee McKown and passed unanimously.

Snider introduced Tony Webb, the new Chief of Police. Several police officers from other agencies as well as Webb's family were present for the swearing in ceremony. Pagnotta swore in Tony Webb as well as new police officer Tommie McLallen As a part time officer. Mayor Christensen thanked Officer Kizer and the reserve officers for their hard work while the town was without a chief.

Resolution 779-10 Ratifying Police wages - Trustee Hitchcock made a motion approving the employment of certain employees and establishing wages for the new hires. Chief of police wages were set at \$42,000 per year and the part time police officer's wages were set at a starting rate of \$10 per hour. Motion was seconded by Trustee True and passed unanimously.

#### Adjournment

Trustee McKown made a motion to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Trustee True and passed unanimously.
