SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

Mayor Wards called this special council meeting to order at 7:10 p.m. Present were Trustees Christensen, Hitchcock, Hobby, and Stites. Trustee McKown was absent. Also present were, Klinkerman, Snider, Borrego, Rein and Pagnotta.

Interview and Vote for Trustee Candidates: Mayor Wards addressed council asking if they had received the two letters of intent that were submitted by Jim Baldwin and Joan Vibber. Mayor Wards stated that Baldwin had to attend a training course and was not able to attend this meeting. Mayor Wards asked if anyone had questions for Vibber. Trustee Stites asked why she wanted to be a town council member. Vibber stated that she felt she had something to offer, she has lots of experience in dealing with groups, and is a team player. She feels that the town has a great deal to offer to not only the valley but to the people of this community and she would like to be part of it. Mayor Wards handed out ballots that were filled out by the council members and counted. Jim Baldwin received three votes and Joan Vibber received one. Baldwin will be sworn in at the next regular council meeting that will be held September 28, 2009 and will fill the position until the next regular election that will be held in April 2010.

Bids for Tractor and Road grader: Trustee Hitchcock stated that the Utility Board would like to add the tractor to the release for bids in conjunction to the road grader. He made a motion to that we put the tractor and road grader up for bids. This equipment will be sold and replaced with a 4 wheel drive tractor that has a cab and snow plow and quick connect bucket. Motion was seconded by Trustee Christensen. Motion passed unanimously.

Adjournment: Trustee Hobby made a motion to adjourn; motion was seconded by Trustee Stites. Motion passed unanimously.
