

## **RESOLUTION 738-08**

### A RESOLUTION ADOPTING TOWN OF FOWLER'S 2008 CALENDAR.

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Town of Fowler establish a regular Board of Trustees meeting and holiday schedule and designate the official publication and posting location for calendar year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF FOWLER, COLORADO THAT:

The Town of Fowler Board of Trustees will conduct its regular meetings on the second and fourth Monday of each month commencing at 6:00 p.m. in Board of Trustees Chambers located at 200 Main Street; Fowler, Colorado with the following exception. Where a town holiday, as set forth below, falls on a Monday regular meeting date the regular meeting date shall be the Tuesday, immediately following the Monday holiday.

The 2008 official schedule for the Town of Fowler for 2008 shall be:

Christmas Day .....	Thursday, December 25, 2008

The official publication, in which legal notices shall be published from time to time for the Town of Fowler, is hereby designated as the Fowler Tribune. Alternate official publications shall be the Rocky Ford Daily Gazette and the La Junta Tribune Democrat. The Board of Trustees finds that each of these publications is a legal publication of general circulation within the Town of Fowler.

The official posting site for 2008 shall be the Town of Fowler Town Hall; 200 Main Street; Fowler, Colorado.
